The Associate Missionaries of St. Paul (AMSP)

### Benefits of Members

Associates members are remembered daily in the prayers of the MSP priests. They share in the fruits of the Mass offered every First Friday by the MSP priests and are encouraged to promote her charism and mission.

Associate members benefit from opportunities to pray with the MSP priests at Masses, prayer services and participate in special MSP celebrations.

Through a special Solemn Admission Ceremony, a formal relationship is established between the Associates and the Missionaries of St. Paul.

AMSP, who are able, make mission trips/pilgrimages to where MSP priests are working.

In case of bereavement, MSP priests are obliged to offer three masses for the repose of the soul of a member, and where possible attend the funeral of a member; and visit with family members.
